

Outreach and Interfaith Committee -Fall Activities 2024

The following are some the activities that the committee has been involved in since September, 2024.

Soup kitchen: This year GBT joined the consortium of faith-based organizations in Carroll County to provide a hot midday meal to the homeless 4-5 times a year on a rotational basis. The committee members have so far planned, obtained supplies, cooked and served in the soup kitchen since March and will go on till November at the Westminster United Methodist Church in downtown Westminster in Carroll County. We serve hot vegetarian meals each time. We plan to continue this service in 2025.

Alzheimer's Walkathon- Saturday October 26, 2024. This year due to other major events going on at the temple the Walkathon effort was a subdued affair. Hoping to enhance the involvement next year as it's a devastating disease in our society and more people need to be aware of and learn ways to prevent it.

Annual Diwali Food and Clothing Drive - October 12-Nov 17. The committee is thankful for the wonderful response from our congregation to help less privileged people with basic needs. The food and clothing will be distributed to the needy in Carroll County and Baltimore County.

Interfaith Activities: The committee is a participant in the Carroll County Interfaith Alliance for Racial justice. This will help to learn about social injustices in the community at large and the efforts to remedy them. Members of the committee take part in discussing topics on Hinduism with church groups.
